FLUOR / Government Group is currently recruiting for work positions available for a government group in Afghanistan.

Positions for:

- * Five (5) Journeyman refrigeration Mechanics
- * Fourteen (14) Journeyman HVAC Technicians
- * Ten (10) Journeyman Plumbers

There are several criteria for this posting which include:

- Military experience an asset but not required

Journeyman Refrigeration (5 positions)

- Performs maintenance, troubleshooting, repair and installation of refrigeration equipment and components in accordance with project requirements and equipment specifications.
- Tests lines, components and connections using electrical, mechanical and pneumatic test equipment.
- Performs soldering and brazing.
- Checks refrigeration systems for leaks; monitors refrigerant levels and charges system as needed. May support HVAC operations and personnel as required.
- Performs work site preparation and cleanup. Follows safe work practices and maintains a safe work environment at all times.
- Under general supervision, responsible for general maintenance and repair of reefer units, refrigerated containers, and/or ice refrigeration units.
- Assists in everyday maintenance of large and small refrigeration units and may assist HVAC departments as needed.
- Ensures work orders are completed according to contractual obligations, military regulations, and health standards.
- May be assigned to an Ice Plant, transportation department, or maintenance department.
- May supervise a team of subcontractor, and/or labor broker personnel, in accordance with the "General Supervisory Duties and Responsibilities" addendum

Journeyman HVAC (14 positions)

- Maintains, installs, and repairs air conditioning, refrigeration, and heating units and related equipment as assigned.
- Diagnoses causes of equipment breakdowns, tests parts with appropriate instruments, disassembles and assembles parts, and makes necessary repairs. Checks levels of refrigerant; adds or replaces refrigerant using appropriate tools and methods to maintain proper control of gas at all times.
- Studies building plans and working drawings to determine work aids required and sequence of installations. May measure windows or other existing openings, or cut through walls, using a mallet, cold chisel, or other tools to install new units. May drill holes to mount units and lift parts into position.
- Locates and marks position of pipe and/or duct connections and passage holes for same in walls and floors, using ruler, spirit level, and plumb bob. Cuts openings in walls and floors to accommodate pipe and/or duct fittings, using hand tools and power tools. Cuts and threads pipe, using pipe cutters, cutting torch, and pipe-threading machine. Connects motors to control panels and balances motors to ensure efficient operation.
- Connects control panels to power source. May weld holding fixtures to steel structural members.

Journeyman Plumber (10 positions)

- Performs plumbing work as assigned. Assembles, installs, and repairs pipes, fittings, and fixtures of heating, water, and drainage systems, according to specifications and plumbing codes.
- Studies building plans and working drawings to determine work aids required and sequence of installations.
- Inspects structure to ascertain obstructions to be avoided to prevent weakening of structure resulting from installation of pipe.
- Locates and marks position of pipe and pipe connections and passage holes for pipes in walls and floors, using ruler, spirit level, and plumb bob.
- Cuts openings in walls and floors to accommodate pipe and pipe fittings, using hand tools and power tools. Cuts and threads pipe, using pipe cutters, cutting torch, and pipe-threading machine.
- Bends pipe to required angle by use of pipe-bending machine or by placing pipe over block and bending it by hand.
- Assembles and installs valves, pipe fittings, and pipes composed of metals, such as iron, steel, brass, and lead, and nonmetals, such as glass, vitrified clay, and plastic, using hand tools and power tools.
- Joins pipes by use of screws, bolts, fittings, solder, plastic solvent, and calks joints.
- Fills pipe system with water or air and reads pressure gauges to determine whether system is leading.
- Installs and repairs plumbing fixtures, such as sinks, commodes, bathtubs, water heaters, hot water tanks, garbage disposal units, dishwashers, and water softeners.
- Repairs and maintains plumbing, by replacing washers in leaky faucets, mending burst pipes, and opening clogged drains.
- Follows safe work practices and maintains a clean, safe work area at all times.
