<p>COMMENTS:</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Effective August 23 – September 27, 2021, CNRL will facilitate mandatory Rapid Antigen testing at both Calgary and Edmonton flight terminals to support the Albian and Horizon outages. ➤ All new contract workers to site will be required to complete this COVID test to obtain clearance to check-in and board flights, regardless of their personal vaccination status. ➤ All new contractors must arrive at the flight terminal at least 2 hrs. prior to their scheduled flight departure time. ➤ Regular CNRL and contractor FIFO travelers are asked to arrive at the flight terminals at least 1 hr. prior to scheduled flight departure time to avoid congestion. ➤ Contractors that test positive for Covid-19 they will be provided with their test results, denied flight boarding and advised to make arrangements to safely isolate as per AHS guidelines, after having contacted their employer. ➤ Asymptomatic on site Rapid Antigen testing will continue at both Horizon McKay camp, Horizon PUG and Albian Village locations throughout the duration of both Albian and Horizon outages.
