#### **Course Overview**

This self-guided online course is designed to prepare UA Local 488 member Alberta registered Gasfitter apprentices for the AIT Class B Gasfitter exam. This APTC course includes content from both 1<sup>st</sup> year Common Core and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Gasfitter.

Students must be an active Alberta gasfitter apprentice or be accepted into the Alberta trade qualification program to potentially be eligible to write the Alberta Gasfitter B certification exam.

Key elements of this program are electrical applications for appliances up to 400 MBH, gas systems, appliances up to 400 MBH, venting and air supply, and commissioning and servicing.

This self-directed course requires the student to complete the work with limited guidance. Students can receive help via email and discussion threads with an expectation of a teacher response within 24 hours. A class Microsoft Teams meeting will be held every Wednesday morning from 7:30 am -8:30 am for the duration of the class.

Manage your time appropriately, as there is a great deal of content to review. Do the initial assessment test early on. This assessment will show you your weak points. Alberta Pipe Trades College is here to support their students and will help each student to the best of our capacity to achieve success.

Students should register with APTC as soon as possible, as class seats are limited. Student registrations will be accepted for this program at any time before July 1, 2023 based upon class seat availability. Student access to this on-line course will be removed Aug 31, 2023. This online program will be offered again in the fall of 2023.
